A Small and Secret World

The following miniature collection of dolls' houses, miniatures, windmill, etc. is from the Estate of Mavis Priestley, member of the New Zealand Association of Miniature Enthusiasts Inc. (NZAME).

Mavis & Peter Priestly, founder member of the NZAME, and were fully involved in the growth and activities of the association.

Mavis & Peter met and married in England during WWII. Peter, a New Zealander, was overseas with the NZAF and Mavis was serving with the RAF. At the end of the war they returned to New Zealand and finally settled in Devonport in 1949. Peter worked at the Devonport Naval Base then on the Devonport ferries and coastal shipping as an engineer until his retirement in 1981.

Mavis was interested in dolls and dolls' houses since early childhood and made and collected dolls and soft toys for many years. In 1977 she became interested in antique dolls and through her association with the Auckland Dolls Club became interested in miniature making and collecting. That year Peter and Mavis embarked on an elaborate project building a scale model of a ten room two storey house typical of a 1930s style villa with everything in it. "The House" took approximately 3½ years to build.

Since the completion of the first house, they produced several very original pieces. Peter was a wizard at mechanised exhibits and made the working windmill using only wooden cogs and wheels, and a marvellous carousel with the horses going up and down as the carousel rotated. They also built a beautiful ballroom where the dancers move on the dance floor.

When Peter died in 1990 Mavis continued to be heavily involved in the miniature world doing more miniature model scenes and making many small miniatures which were greatly sort after, many going overseas. Mavis took many workshops at seminars in New Zealand, Australia and America. She became an Honorary Tutor of the NZAME. Her and Peter's work has featured in different media through the years and Mavis continued her miniature work right up to the time of her death at the end of 2009.

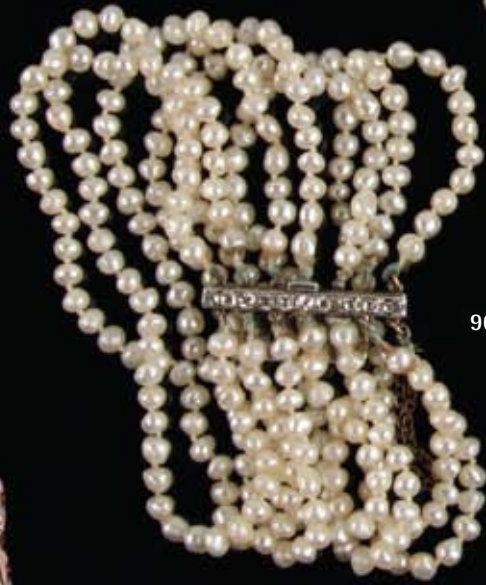

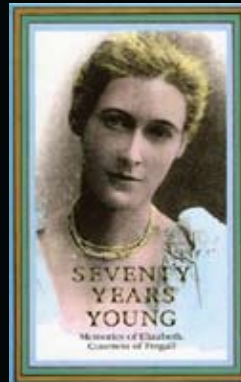

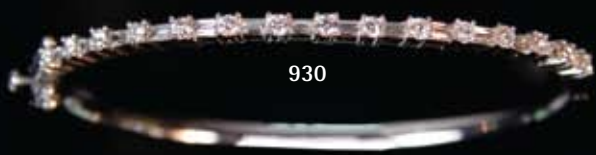
